The regatta is organised by the Yacht Club Costa Smeralda (YCCS) , in collaboration with Boat International Group in occasion of the Silver Jubilee of the Boat International Magazine, from the 22nd to the 26th June 2008.

The Race Headquarters for the Regatta will be located at the Yacht Club Costa Smeralda Clubhouse in Porto Cervo Marina.

2-BOAT ELIGIBILITY

The regatta is open to the following yachts:
- IRC rated yachts with LOA over 80'.
- IMA yachts with LOA over 80'.
- Classic and Spirit of Tradition yachts with LOA over 80' at the discretion of the Organising Authority.

The fleet may be split, according to the number of entries, into different groups/divisions at the discretion of the O.A.

The Boat International Superyacht Regatta includes the 2008 Southernwind Cup.

3-RULES

3.1 -The regatta will be governed by:

- International Sailing Federation Racing Rules of Sailing 2005/2008 (RRS)
- Special Regulations governing Offshore Racing for Category 3 with life raft on board compulsory. Life rafts are items of live saving equipment. Attention is drawn to RRS 1.2 (Life saving equipment and personal buoyancy).

- IRC Rules and Regulations.

- IMA Class Rules and Regulations (for IMA Trophy)

- Italian competitors shall be in compliance with the Italian Sailing Federation Rules (FIV). Other Italian Federation prescriptions do not apply.

Power assisted winches, canting keels, trim tab and water ballast are permitted.

3.2 -English shall be the official language used at the Regatta.

4-MEASUREMENT AND CONTROLS

4.1 -Boats may be inspected and/or check measured at any reasonable time before or during the regatta.

4.2 -Boats shall only be measured by measurers pre-approved by the O.A.

4.3 -IRC certificates may be issued by either the RORC Rating Office: (info@rorc-rating.com) or the UNCL Centre de Calcul: (irc@uncl.com).

5-SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available for competitors upon final registration.

6-EVENT CLASSIFICATION AND ADVERTISING

6.1 -The regatta is designated Category C, under ISAF Advertising code, Regulation 20.

6.2 -All participating boats are requested to hoist a backstay sponsor's pennant, a battle flag with the logo of the event. The battle flag shall be flown while moored.

6.3 -The Organising Authority may also require:

- the installation, at no cost to competitors, of on board video cameras for the official television production.

- to have TV cameramen on board in excess of the crew weight limit.

7-JURISDICTION

The regatta will be sailed under the jurisdiction of the Race Committee and the International Jury appointed in accordance with RRS 90 (b) and Appendix N2. All decisions of the International Jury shall be final as approved in RRS 70.4.

Race means coastal courses.

The Organising Authority and/or the Race Committee reserves the right to modify the above programme according to weather conditions or other unforeseen reasons.

3 races are scheduled with no discard.

9- RACING AREA AND CHARTS

The racing area will be in North Eastern Sardinian waters. The following charts are recommended: nos. 42 – 43 - 323 – 324 – 325 – 910, Italian charts of the Istituto Idrografico della Marina. 10- ENTRIES AND ENTRY FEE

10.1 -Entries shall be made on the Entry Form available on the YCCS web site (www.yccs.it) and shall be received, completed in full, by the Yacht Club Costa Smeralda not later than May 1st 2008, accompanied by a non-refundable entry fee of 4.000 Euro per yacht. The entry fee for IMA Members, is reduced to 50% (Euro 2.000,00).

10.2 -Each entry shall also be accompanied by one copy of the current rating certificate.

If a boat elects to reconfigure the sail plan or change any other measurement values requiring a new rating certificate, the new certificate shall be received by the O.A. by 1400 hours on 22nd June 2008.

10.3 -Any boat intending to display advertising during the regatta shall state in the entry form the nature of such advertising. The O.A. reserves the right to accept entries when more than one boat are advertising the same brand.

Boats are responsible to inform advertisers and sponsors that no activities advertising any brand advertised on competing boats will be permitted ashore within the Porto Cervo Marina Area without the consent in writing of the O.A. obtained before the start of the Regatta

The Organising Authority reserves the right to accept entries after 1st May 2008. Each entry will be confirmed not later than 15th of May, 2008.

For late entries moorings are not guaranteed and mooring fees are not included in the entry fee.

10.4 -The entry fee can be paid by Credit Card (VISA or MASTERCARD) or by bank transfer as stated in detail in the entry form.

11-REGISTRATION

11.1 -Final Registration formalities shall be completed at the Yacht Club Costa Smeralda's Race Office by 16.00 hours 22nd June 2008. In exceptional circumstances the International Jury or the Organising Authority may give consent to a boat to register late.

11.2 - All competitors shall be in compliance with the ISAF eligibility rules

11.3 -Italian competitors shall be in compliance with the Italian Sailing Federation Rules (FIV)

11.4 -Foreign competitors shall be in compliance with their respective National Rules.

12- SCORING AND PENALTIES

The Low Point System RRS Appendix A shall apply.

13- ELECTRONIC AIDS

All types of electronic equipment are permitted.

14- COMMUNICATIONS

All boats shall be equipped with a Marine VHF transceiver operating on VHF channel 71 and on VHF channel 9.

15- INSPECTIONS

Boats shall be at the disposal of the Measurement & Inspection Committee not later than 10.00 hours on June 22nd, 2008. For boats already in Porto Cervo, inspections may be carried out on 21st June, 2008.

16- TROPHIES AND PRIZES

- The Boat International Silver Jubilee Cup to best overall classified yacht.

- Rolex watch to the best overall classified yacht.

- Special trophy will be awarded to the best scored Southernwind Yacht.

- Special trophy will be awarded to the best scored Dubois Yacht.

- IMA Trophy for the best scored IMA Member.

- Additional special trophies to the winner of each finalised group.

17-MOORINGS

17.1 -The entry fee includes mooring fees from 08.00 hours on June 22nd to 10.00 hours on June, 27th 2008, at Porto Cervo Marina or Port East provided that the completed entry form and entry fee are received by the Yacht Club Costa Smeralda before 1st May 2008.

17.2 -No moorings are guaranteed for late entries.

17.3 -The cost of electricity, water consumption and telephone charges as well as mooring fees for late entries and/or additional periods, must be paid directly to the Marina Office by the participants.

The VHF Channel of the Harbourmaster is VHF channel 9: all the boats shall contact the Harbourmaster every time the boat enters or leaves the harbour. Sailing is forbidden in the harbour.

20- DISCLAIMER

Competitors agree to be bound by the International Sailing Federation Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2005/2008, by the Sailing Instructions and the Notice of Race. Competitors agree to take any and all responsibility for the nautical qualities of their boat, the rigging, the crew's ability and the safety equipment. Competitors also agree to take any and all responsibility for damages caused to third persons or their belongings, to themselves or to their belongings, ashore and at sea as a consequence of their participation in the regatta, relieving of any responsibility Boat International, the Yacht Club Costa Smeralda and all persons or sponsors involved in the organization under whatever qualification and to accept full responsibility for the behaviour and dress of the boat's crew, representatives and guests.

Competitors are to be acquainted with ISAF RRS Part 1 Fundamental Rule 4: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone".

In any case, competitors agree that the Yacht Club Costa Smeralda, Rolex S.A. , Boat International Group, the sponsors and their agents, have no responsibility for loss of life or injury to members or others, or for the loss or damage to any vessel or property.

As part of the registration process, each individual participating crew member will be required to sign a declaration accepting this disclaimer of liability.

21- MEDIA RIGHTS

Competitors grant the Organizing Authority, the unrestricted right and permission to use the name and the image for any text, photograph or video footage of either themselves or the boat they are sailing during the event to be published or broadcast in any media whatsoever (including but not limited to Press and TV advertisements or Internet), for either editorial or advertising purposes or to be used in press information; in this respect, competitors' names and any biographical material of themselves may also be used or reproduced in any way known. As part of the registration process, each individual participating crew member will be required to sign a declaration accepting this waiver of rights.

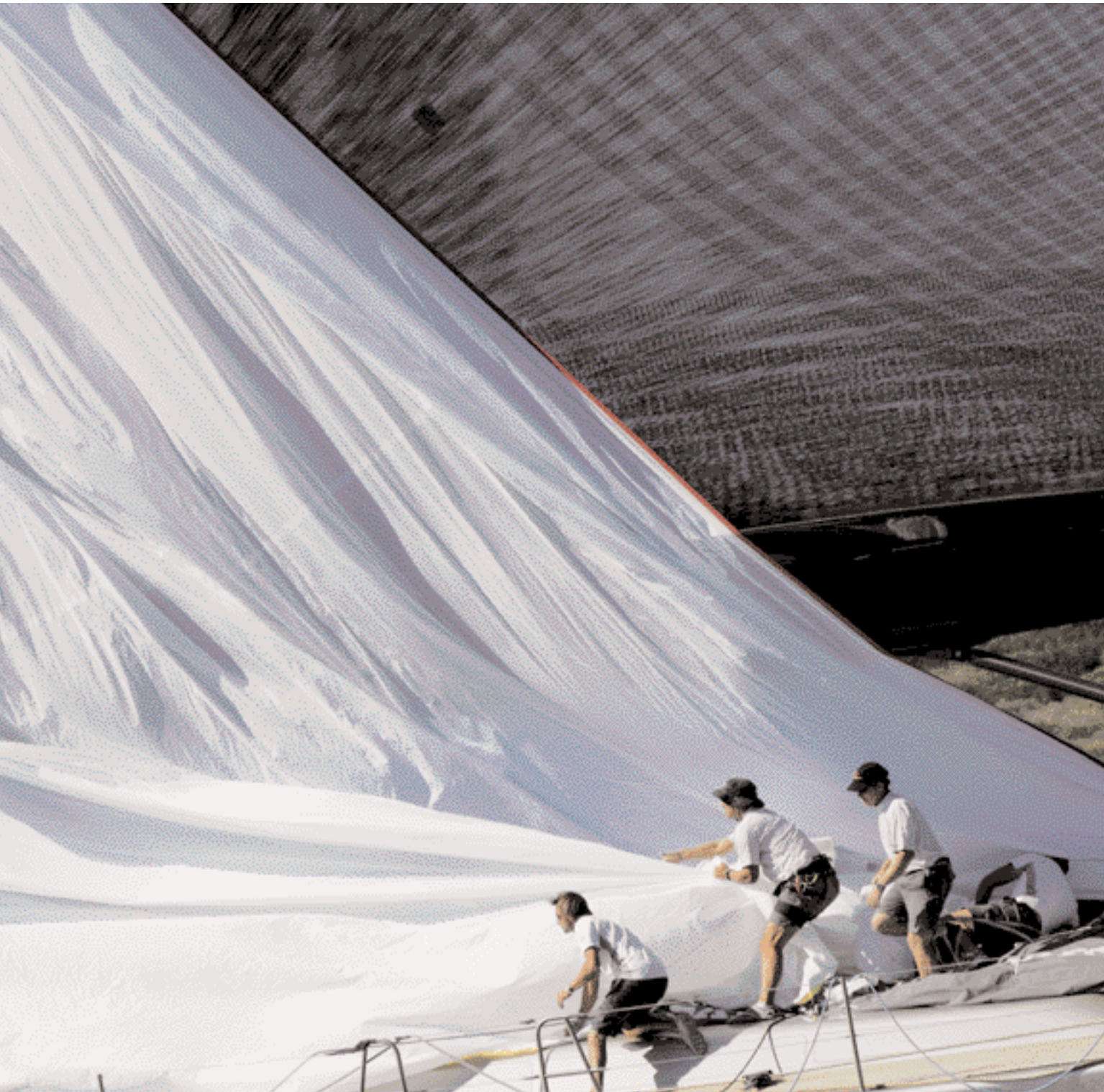

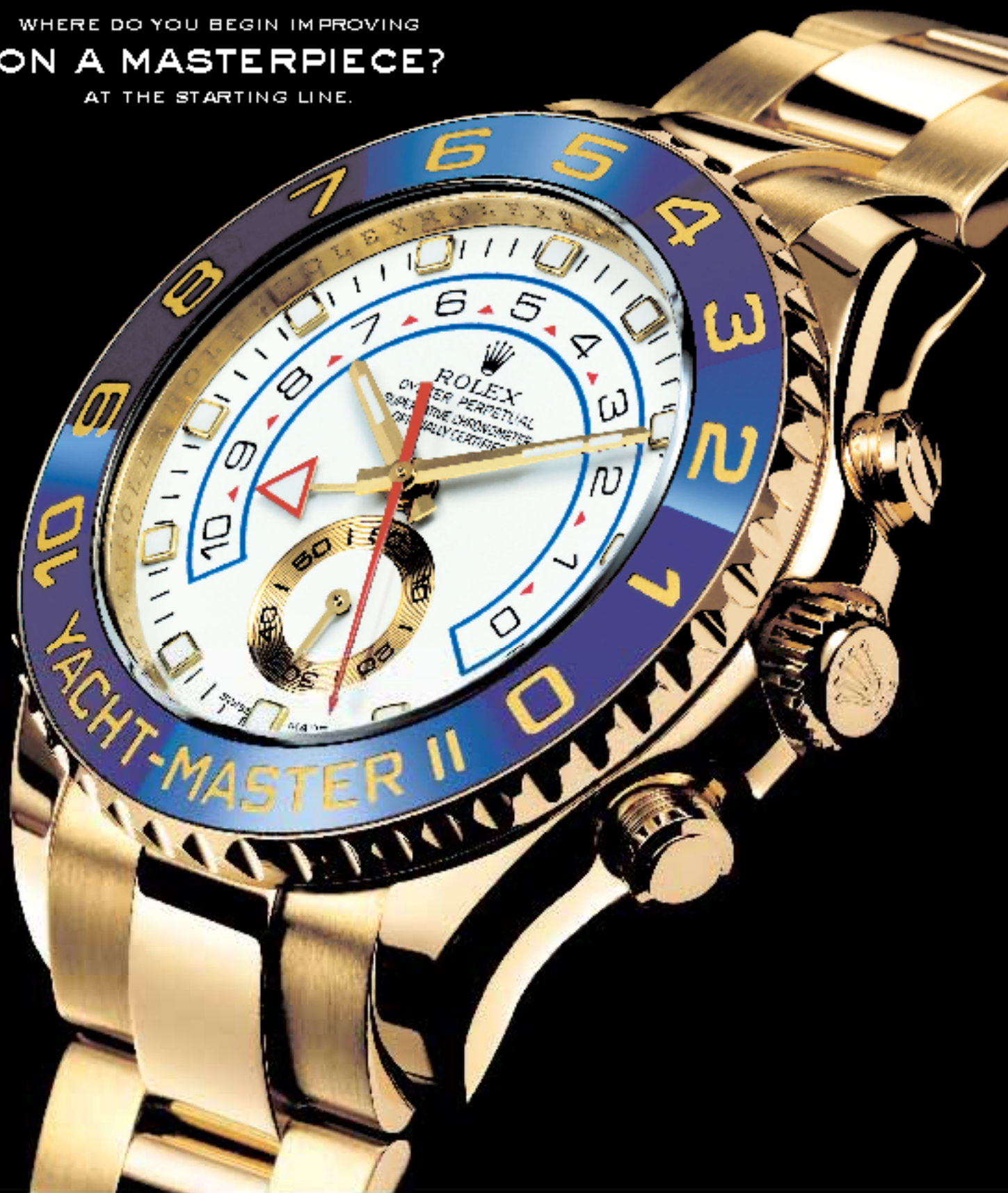
