Sailing Instruction Amendment N. 4

APPENDIX BRAVO

2.6 Marks for the various courses

Add the following two marks (to be used for Course N. 99 only):

- Mark UNIFORM: Yellow inflatable mark - position to be broadcast
- Mark VICTOR: Yellow inflatable mark – position to be broadcast

2.8 Additional Marks of the Course

Add the following to 2.8:

“This also applies for Mark ECHO to Mark BRAVO.

Additionally, the Race Committee has added two yellow inflatable marks, designated marks ‘UNIFORM’ and ‘VICTOR’ to be used on Course N. 99 only. The location of these marks, if used, will be broadcast to competitors prior to the warning signal.”



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Sailing Instruction Amendment N. 3

Add to SI 12.1: “However, for the Wally Category, RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.”

Unofficial clarification: Wally Class Rules cannot change RRS 44.1, thus a Sailing Instructions amendment is necessary.

2.6 Marks for the various courses

Substitute Mark GOLF with “Yellow inflatable mark positioned approximately 300 meters east of Beacon of Secca Tre Monti”.



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Sailing Instruction Amendment N. 1

Delete and replace 21.2 with:

With the exception of the Maxi Racing Category, support boats shall stay outside areas where boats are racing from the time of the preparatory signal for the first class to start until all boats have finished, the race committee signals a postponement, general recall or abandonment or until the boat supported has retired.

Unofficial clarification: Some boats in the Maxi Racing Category do not have life lines. All boats in that class were given dispensation per SI 22 should there be a man overboard.
