QUESTIONS RECEIVED FROM COMPETITORS

Q1.

The contractual agreement between the Marina and the diving company is clear that cleaning work on hulls is forbidden without special authorisation. Which means it is possible and if the divers are hired for cleaning work from the Marina I guess once the Marina supplies the divers the authorisation is then given.

I then presume the Marina has the right to give the authorisation?

A1

NO. The sailing instruction is independent of any external authorization or agreement between third parties.

Q2. Does a special permission granted by the harbormaster or another entity override the prohibitions in SI 18.3 for the "Maxi Rolex" or SI 17.3 for the Maxi72?

A2. No.

Q3. What are the geographic limits of SI 18.3 for the Maxi Yacht Rolex Cup or SI 17.3 for the Rolex Maxi 72 World Championship?

A3. The restrictions contained in SI 18.3 for the Maxi Yacht Rolex Cup or SI 17.3 for the Rolex Maxi 72 Worlds Championship apply to the event venue, including the harbor, mooring field and racing area, part of which is in the "Parco Nazionale dell'arcipelago della Maddalena".

Q4. What authority does the RC have for issuing SI 18.3 for the Maxi Yacht Rolex Cup or SI 17.3 for the Rolex Maxi72 World Championship?

A4. The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS 90.2).
