SAILING INSTRUCTIONS AMENDMENT No.3

Delete old C4.1 and replace with new C4.1:

“C4.1 CREW POSITIONING

Crew shall not stand, sit or lay on the safety lines apart from the stern rails as far as there are no legs to the outside. Leaning out over cockpit safety lines to increase hiking leverage is allowed while sitting on the deck.

The use of the shrouds (including any inner shrouds) above the lower bottle screw (turnbuckle), stanchions, lifelines or cockpit safety lines to facilitate tacking or gybing is prohibited.

The use of the shrouds (including any inner shrouds) above the lower bottle screw (turnbuckle) to aid the projection of a crew member outboard is prohibited.”
