# LOCAL SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Abbreviations: PC – protest committee OA – organizing authority SSI – standard sailing instructions LSI – local sailing instructions

RC – race committee RRS – racing rules of sailing NoR – notice of race

# 1. APPLICABLE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1.1 The Sailing Instructions for this event, as required by RRS 90.2, are constituted by these Local Sailing Instructions in conjunction with the 2K Standard Sailing Instructions attached.
- 1.2 The bylaws of the Yacht Club Costa Smeralda which can be seen on our website at <u>www.yccs.com</u> shall apply to all participants.

#### 2. RACE OFFICE

- 2.1 The race office is located at the Yacht Club Costa Smeralda.
- 2.2 The race office will be open on Wednesday, 15<sup>th</sup> June:
  - (a) For registration between 10.00 and 18.00
    - (b) Daily between 10.00 and 18.00
- 2.3 The official notice board will be located in front of the entrance of the YCCS Clubhouse.
- 2.4 Signals made ashore shall be displayed on the official flagpole located at the YCCS Clubhouse

# 3. AMENDMENTS TO THE STANDARD SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 3.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on the ONB, on the YCCS website and will be available at the YCCS Race Office.
- 3.2 In accordance with RRS 90.2(c), changes to the Sailing Instructions may be made on the water by hail on the race committee channel (VHF 72). The Race Committee will display flag L with one sound before making the announcement.

# 4. BOATS AND SAILS

- 4.1 The event will be sailed in J70 boats.
- 4.2 Boats will be identified by flags, sail numbers/hull numbers.
- 4.3 Boats will be equipped with the items as detailed in Addendum G.

# 5. CREW MEMBERS, NUMBER and SAFETY

- 5.1 The total number of crew for one team, including the skippers, shall be 6.
- 5.2 An adequate personal flotation device (minimum standard ISO 12402-5 (EN393): 50N) shall be worn by all crew members at all times whilst afloat.
- 5.3 While racing leg/s shall be inside the sheerline.

# 6. EVENT PROGRAMME, EVENT FORMAT AND STARTING SCHEDULES

- 6.1 A list of eligible teams and the starting schedules are detailed in LSI Addendum E.
- 6.2 The event program and event format are detailed in LSI Addendum F.
- 6.3 The racing days are scheduled for 16<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup>, 18<sup>th</sup> June.
- 6.4 The intended time of the first warning signal each day is 11.30.

# 7. RACING AREA and COURSE

7.1 The racing area will be in front of Porto Cervo Harbour.



7.2 The courses as specified below will be used.



With the configuration displayed above four Courses can be used.

- Course 1 Start 1-2-3-1-2 Finish
- Course 2 Start 1-3-1 Finish
- Course 3 Start 1-2 Finish
- Course 4 Start 1- Finish

# 7.3 Description of Marks

- (a) The Race Committee boat will be identified by a large burgee of the YCCS. The Race Committee boat will normally be the starting boat;
- (b) The starting/finishing line will be a red mark;
- (c) Marks 1, 2 and 3 will be yellow marks

# ADDENDUM I – DAMAGE PROCEDURE & DAMAGE REPORT

In the harbour and between the races YCCS team will observe boats, make notes of any contact and check for damage.

# **Contact while Racing:**

In case of any contact the Umpires will decide in case of any protests. After that they will inform RC by radio, naming boat numbers and areas of contact: E.g. "Contact between boat 5 starboard side and boat 4 bow".

After the race the YCCS team will check and inform the umpires about the level:

A = up to one manhour repair, boat may race without repair;

B = more than 1 hour and less than 5 hours to repair; boat may need some (temporary) work before racing again;

C = more than 5 hours repair; significant work required before racing again.

YCCS team will make photos and notes about every single issue. The umpires will decide about additional penalties and inform RC (for results). RC will inform office for results adjustments and for deposit reduction.

# Other damages while racing:

If the umpires realize any damage during a race they will inform RC immediately about the damage (e.g. "Tiller extension broken on boat number 2").

RC will inform YCCS team to prepare repair and inform race office about deposit deduction.

At the end of the day YCCS team and race office will compare documentation and deposit deduction. RC will crosscheck results.
