**The Bentley Trophy**

The Bentley Trophy will be awarded to the fastest yacht sailing one approximative nautical mile between two gates.

When flag Foxtrot is hoisted by the Race Committee together with the numerical pennant n°1, the gates will be included in the course between Punta Rossa and Isle of Pecora.

The first gate will be the metallic buoy south-west of the Punta Rossa green lighthouse and an orange inflatable buoy positioned at about 1000 metres S.E. of the buoy.

The second gate will be between the Isle of Pecora and an orange inflatable mark positioned at about 1000 metre S.E. of the island
