

Notice no 1 – Organizing Authority

Re.: Rating Certificates

Amendment to the Notice of Race - Paragraph 11.1

If a boat elects to reconfigure the sail plan or change any other measurement values requiring a new rating certificate, the new certificate shall be received by the Organizing Authority by 1200 hours on 3rd September, 2006.

The IMA Technical Office has arranged with the RORC Rating Office in Lymington and with UVAI Office in Rome to process certificate requests received by that office until 1700 on 2nd September, 2006. Copies of new certificates will be sent directly to the IMA Technical Office to be properly signed by the owner in order to become valid.

Boats intending to change certificates should notify the IMA Technical Office of that intention so that arrangements can be made to validate the new certificate received from the RORC Rating Office in a timely manner.

It is reminded to all the competitors in the Racing Division that the rating certificate shall be endorsed.
