In accordance with NOR 6.1 and the weighing and measurement protocol posted on the event website 30 July, 2012, the Organizing Authority intended to weigh all boats participating in the Mini Maxi Rolex World Championship 2012 prior to racing, that do not exceed the lifting capacity of 35 tons.

After experiencing an equipment failure involving a boat's lifting apparatus on 30<sup>th</sup> August 2012, which imposed a shock to the certified load cell used in the process, weighing was suspended. Arrangements have been made for a replacement certified load cell to be delivered this week. This may provide the Organizing Authority with the ability to weigh boats, if necessary.

Given the circumstance that all boats cannot be subject to weight verification, the Organizing Authority does not intend to conduct further weight verifications. However, the Organizing Authority reserves the right to weigh additional boats during or immediately following the event, at its sole discretion.

The planned weighing has been suspended until further notice.

Yesterday during the weight check of a boat in Portisco, a component of the boat's lifting rig failed during the lifting process causing a shock to the recently certified load cell.

The engineers at the company that manufactured and certified the load cell have indicated that the load cell should be checked and re-certified.

In order for the Organizing Authority and competitors to have full confidence in the weighing process, the scale will either be re-certified or replaced with an alternate unit of the same quality but this may not occur before the beginning of the Rolex Mini Maxi World Championship.

The Organizing Authority will require that some boats be available for weighing during the event and /or the three top scored boats be available for weighing immediately after the finish of last race of the event.

That in order to validate the displacement value displayed on the IRC certificate using the protocol for equipment checks under the IRC rule.
