8.5 The Classification Protest Time Limit will be at the close of the scheduled official protest time on the first day of racing.

### **14 MEASUREMENT AND CONTROL**

#### **Delete sentence**

14.1 “The time limit for rating protests will expire two hours after ratings are posted (alters RRS 61.3) except for protests arising from unauthorised changes to the boat that would affect the rating made after that posting.”

8.6 A Representative of the ISAF Sailor Classification Commission will be present during and after Registration to conduct spot checks of crew's classifications. The ISAF Classification Representative may change the status of any sailor after the appropriate interview with immediate effect.
