4. SAILING PROGRAMME AND SCHEDULE OR RACES

4.1 Delete and replace Thursday, 10th September and Friday, 11th September with:

Thursday, 10th September Race(s)

Friday, 11th September Lay Day or Re-sail

4.6 Delete and replace "originally scheduled" with "re-scheduled".

Clarification: The Lay Day has been moved from Thursday to Friday based on forecasts for very light winds on Friday. The IMA Annual General Meeting will be held on Friday as opposed to Thursday.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS AMENDMENT No.1

Paragraph 6 - Courses, Marks, and areas that are obstructions

6.3 (b) – **Delete and replace with:** "Marks laid by the Race Committee for both W/L and Coastal Courses, will be white inflatable buoys except for Mark Bravo and Zulu which will be yellow"

6.5 – Delete and replace with: "The starting and finishing marks for W/L Courses, if used, will be white inflatable buoys".

APPENDIX BRAVO

2.5 Prohibited Passages

Delete and replace "between the Secca Corsara and the Isle of Spargi" with: "between INDIA (beacon of Secca Corsara) and the Isle of Spargi"

2.6 Marks for the various courses

Delete and replace Mark BRAVO with:

- Mark BRAVO: Mark in Pevero Bay, located approximately 1,500 meters south east of the red light at the

entrance of Porto Cervo (approx. Lat. 41.07.80 / - Long. 09.33.30). Yellow mark with a

white flashing light at night.

Delete and replace Mark ZULU with:

- Mark ZULU: Starboard end of the finishing line, located approximately 1,200 meters east of the red light

at the entrance of Porto Cervo (approx. Lat. 41.08.20 / - Long. 09.33.20). Yellow mark with

a white flashing light at night.

Delete and replace Mark DELTA with:

- Mark DELTA: Inflatable buoy positioned ENE of Saline Bay.

Lat. 41.10.15 - Long. 09.26.13

2.9 Change of Course after the Start

Delete and replace 2.9 Change of Course after the Start with: "The Race Committee may change the course at a rounding mark by signalling all boats before they round that mark. A service boat will be stationed near the mark and will signal the change by displaying:

- International Code Flag C
- The Letter of the new mark or marks in the order they are to be passed on a white board.

The new mark or marks will be from those designated in APPENDIX BRAVO 2.6. The Race Committee will also broadcast any course change on VHF 72. This changes Rule 33."

Course n. 8

The course description for Course n. 8 is correct. The course diagram (course marked) is incorrect.
