Use of DRONES

For the duration of the Maxi Yacht Rolex Cup and Rolex Maxi72 World Championship (5 -12 September 2015) the use of drones is forbidden in the racing areas as identified in Appendix Bravo of the Sailing Instructions, unless authorized by the Organizer.

Any drone use approved by the Organizer must be in full compliance with Italian and local law with the operator/pilot assuming in writing full responsibility for compliance with all law and regulations, as well as being adequately insured for third party liability.

SKIPPER'S BRIEFING QUESTIONS

Q1. Will the Maxi Racer and Maxi Racer/Cruisers sail in the same categories and will they have the same start?

A. The Maxi Racer and Maxi Racer/Cruisers will be racing in different categories and scored separately, but will share the same start.

Q2. The NOR states that 4 boats are needed to constitute a category – why are there categories with less than 4 boats?

A. The IMA Class Rules were changed in January allowing for less than 4 boats in a category. An NOR amendment will be published clarifying this change.

Q3. Does the category flag need to be displayed on the backstay?

A. Yes, Maxi Yacht Rolex Cup boats (not Maxi 72s) must display their category flag. An SI amendment will be published clarifying this requirement.
