Clarification on use of different sails upwind

Using a sail upwind means tacking to reach the proper course for the next mark.

A reaching sail for large and heavy SUPERYACHTS like the Perini Navi is considered a sail that can be used at angles wider than 65° even if the VPP, considering a larger range of SUPERYACHTS, is taking into account boats sailing with a reacher up to 52° .

If a Perini can use a reacher at angles smaller than 65° it means that this sail shall be declared as upwind sail.

Q1. The diagram of Course n. 13 in Appendix BRAVO appears to be wrong?
