Paragraph 3 – Eligibility

Replace with:

3. Eligibility:

3.1 The regatta is open to boats with LH of 90 feet or above with a 2020 ORCsy Handicap Certificate or ORCcs (Corinthian Spirit Class) handicap certificate. The OA retains the right to invite any boat or class of interest regardless of LH .

Paragraph 4 – Division and Classes

Replace with:

4.2 Depending on fleet composition, it is the intent of the race committee to have superyachts divided in Cruising Division, Performance Division, Corinthian Spirit Division and a 90-99 feet Cruising Division. The Divisions may be further divided into Classes, depending on the number of entries, size, speed potential, and performance characteristics of the yachts in each division. Divisions may have different courses, cruising or racing orientated, and starts (pursuit or fleet starts) in accordance with the nature and performances of the yachts.

Paragraph 12. Moorings

Replace with:

12.1 The entry fee includes mooring fees from 10.00 on 2 June to 10.00 on 7 June at Porto Cervo Marina or Port East provided that the entry is completed by the closing date for entries.

Paragraph to be added:

Paragraph 22. Competitors drones

22.1 Teams or their representatives shall not fly drones over the Loro Piana Superyacht Regatta shore base or over the race area during training or racing days without complying with local legislation and in any case unless prior written approval by the organizer has been obtained.

22.2 The approval granted at sole discretion of the organizer may impose similar limitation as applicable to support boats (as better detailed in the SI).

22.3 At any time the risk and responsibility for flying any drone is with the person flying the drone and images made inside the race area shall be shared with the organizer, race committee or jury at reasonable request.
