SKIPPER'S BRIEFING QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Q1. In Appendix BRAVO section 2.5 'Prohibited Passages', does the prohibited passage between the Sardinian coast and the Island of Poveri include the signal post approximately 200 metres NE of the islands?

A. Yes

Q2. In SI 12.7 of the Maxi Yacht Rolex Cup SI you refer to SI section 19 and there is no section 19.

A. Replace "19" with "18" (SI Amendment to follow).

Q3. Is the Supermaxi category racing under RRS Appendix SY?

A. No, the Supermaxi category is racing under the conventional RRS.

Q4. For coastal races, are all marks white?

A. No. Per SI 6.4 (a) in both Sailing Instructions and SI Amendment No.1, all coastal marks are white except for Marks Bravo and Zulu, which are red and the mark for Finishing Line East (Supermaxi category only), which is yellow.

NOTICE TO COMPETITORS N2

A Jury Boat will follow the fleet during each race. If the judge(s) observe an incident in which at least one boat hails protest and displays a red flag, the judges may make one of the following signals:

1. A red flag with one sound means 'The judge(s) believe one or more boat(s) has broken a rule.' The judges will hail or signal each boat identified.
2. A green and white flag with one sound means 'The judge(s) observed the incident and believe that no rule was broken.'
3. A yellow flag with one sound means 'The judge(s) did not observe the incident or are unable to make a decision'.

The signals displayed by the Jury Boat are for information only. If a red flag is displayed, the identified boat is not obligated to take a penalty. If a yellow or green and white flag is displayed, any boat may still protest another boat.
