

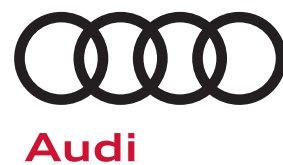

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Programme.

Refer to the NoR at paragraph 7.

The Race Committee reserves the right to modify the event program depending on weather conditions and other unforeseen circumstances.

2. Rules.

- The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the World Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2017-2020;

- In the event of a conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions and the subsequent communications of the Race Committee (RC) shall prevail;

- FIV Prescriptions 2, 4, 5, 6, 9, 10 and 11 will apply. All Italians competitors shall be FIV members and have a valid medical certificate.

- NATIONAL AUTHORITY RULES: every **crew member** shall be in compliance with its National Authority Rules.

3. Official Briefing

The briefing will be held at the YCCS podium area in Piazza Azzurra at 10.30 on Sunday 4th August.

4. Changes to the Sailing Instructions, Notice of Race & Communication to Competitors.

4.1 Any change to the SI, NoR and/or communication to Competitors will be posted on the Official Notice Board (ONB) situated at the YCCS Piazza Azzurra.

4.2 Any changes to the SI, NoR and/or communication to Competitors made at sea will be communicated to all boats by the Race Committee boat orally.

5. Signals made ashore.

5.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed on the official flag staff located at the YCCS Terrace.





5.2 Code flag AP (Answering Pennant) means that the race is postponed. The warning signal will be not displayed prior to 60 minutes after AP is lowered.

6. Marks.

6.1 All marks will be red inflatable marks.

7. Starting Signals.

7.1 The sequence of the starting signals will be as follows (X means the regatta starting time):

Time	Flag	Signals	
X - 5	"YCCS Burgee"	Warning Signal	 ↑
X - 4	"PAPA"	Preparatory Signal	 ↑
X - 1	Lowering of "PAPA"	Last minute	 ↓
X	Lowering of "YCCS Burgee"	Start	 ↓

All signals will be possibly accompanied by a sound signal.

7.2 After the preparatory signal, the helmsman cannot leave the helm for all the duration of that regatta except for emergencies.



8. Official Boats.

8.1 The Race Committee boat will be a YCCS Service boat. The Race Committee boat will be the starting/finishing boat and will be identified by the RC flag.

8.2 Service boats will be identified by a flag with the letter "S" on a white background.

9. Starting Line.

The starting line will be a staff displaying an orange flag on the Race Committee boat and an inflatable red buoy or a service boat displaying an orange flag.

The Race Committee boat on the starting line shall be left to starboard and the buoy or the service boat to port.

10. Finishing Line.


The finishing line will be between a red buoy or a service boat displaying an orange flag and a staff displaying a blue and an orange flag on the Race Committee boat.

The Race Committee boat shall be left to port and the red buoy or the service boat to starboard.

11. Description of the Course.

The courses will be announced at the official briefing and will consist of two coastal races, Porto Cervo - Poltu Quatu and Poltu Quatu - Porto Cervo.

Shortening of the Course:

When the course is shortened at a mark, the finishing line shall be between the mark at which the course is shortened and a Service boat displaying the flag "SIERRA" ().

12. Individual Recalls.

Individual recalls will be made by hoisting the flag "X" (.

13. General Recalls.

General recalls will be made by hoisting the flag "First Substitute" (.

14. Time Limit.

The time limit for the regatta is 17.00.

15. Alternative Penalties.

RRS 44.1 is changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required even for infringement of rules of part 2.

16. Scoring.

The low point system scoring Appendix A applies. Each yacht's score shall be the sum of all her races (no discards).

17. Deposit for vessels damages.

The vessels provided by YCCS include sails and insurance, however in case of damage the responsible skipper is obliged to pay the damage induced or a waiver of a maximum of € 1000. Competitors are required to provide credit card details for payment of the above waiver and to sign for acceptance. In the event of damage the race office will advise the card holder and debit the credit card accordingly.

18. Protests

18.1 Protests shall be written on the form available at the YCCS race office and lodged there within the protest time limit (PTL) posted on the official notice board and will be 60 minutes after the last boat has finished the last race of the day.

18.2 Schedule of hearings will be posted on the ONB. All persons involved in the hearings shall remain in the vicinity of the protest room at YCCS.

18.3 The race committee/protest committee intending to protest a boat under Rule 60.2.a or Rule 60.3.a because of an incident observed in the racing area shall inform her after the race by posting a notice on the ONB within the protest time limit as indicated in paragraph 18.1 of these instructions.

18.4 It is the boat's representative's sole responsibility to check the protest notices at the end of the protest filing time to see if she is cited in a protest. Competitors are reminded of RRS 63.3.b.

1. ORGANISING AUTHORITY (O.A.)

2. ENTRIES

2.1 The regatta is open to all YCCS Members and will be sailed on the J70 boats provided by the YCCS.

2.2 The skippers are required to pay a damage deposit of Euros 1.000,00 € prior to the start of the races. The deposit will be reimbursed at the end of the event.

3. ENTRY FORM AND ENTRY FEE

3.1 Entry form (Attachment 1) shall be submitted to the **YCCS Race Office**,

f. +39/0789/91213 | @. secretariat@yccs.it no later than 31st July, 2019 together with the non refundable entry fee of Euros 500 per Team.

3.2 The entry fee can be paid as per entry form. The entry fee covers the costs for the preparation of the boats, the practice section with the boats and social functions.

4. RULES

The races will be governed by the WS Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 (RRS), including the Notice of Race (NoR) and the Sailing Instructions (SI) when issued. SI will take precedence over the NoR.

5. RACES

The Championship will be held on Sunday 4th August and the regatta will be a fleet race. Course will be detailed in the SI.

6. TEAMS

6.1 Each Team shall be composed of a crew of maximum five people with at least two YCCS Members or family Members. No professionals are allowed to be part of the Team and there will be no weight limit. The skipper shall be a YCCS member. A minimum of three crew is mandatory. FIV Prescriptions 1, 3, 7, 8, 12 and 13 do not apply.

FIV Prescriptions 2, 4, 5, 6, 9, 10 and 11 will apply. For Italian crews only: all Italians crews shall be FIV members and have a valid medical certificate.

6.2 When a registered skipper is unable to continue in the event the O.A. may authorize an original YCCS crew member to substitute.

When a registered crew member is unable to continue in the event, the O.A. may authorize a substitute, a temporary substitute or other adjustment.

6.3 The registered skipper shall helm the yacht at all times while racing, except in an emergency.

6.4 Depending on the number of Teams and participating Members, the O. A. will take care of composing the crews under its responsibility.

8. AWARDS

The winning team will receive the Members' Championship Challenge Trophy and the Skipper will be the Annual Social Champion. Prizes will be awarded to second and third placed teams. Further prizes at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.

9. COURSES AND RACING AREA

Courses will be coastal courses, detailed in the SI.

10. BORROWED BOATS

Every effort shall be made to avoid damage to hulls, rigging and sails. Any damage will be the responsibility of the skipper. Deductibles of the Damage Deposit (as per Paragraph 2.2) will be applied to the skipper of the boat determined to be at fault; either by accepting a penalty or by finding of the O.A..

11. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The SI will be available at the YCCS Race Office upon final registration and published on the YCCS website (www.yccs.com).

12. DISCLAIMER

Competitors agree to be bound by the WS RRS 2017/2020, by the SI and the NoR. Competitors agree to take any and all responsibility for the crew's ability, damages caused to third persons or their belongings, to themselves or to their belongings, ashore and at sea as a consequence of their participation in the regatta, relieving of any responsibility the O.A. and all persons involved in the organization under whatever qualification and to accept full responsibility for the behaviour and dress of the yacht's crew, representatives and guests. Competitors are to be acquainted with World Sailing RRS Part 1 Fundamental Rule 4: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone". In any case competitors agree that the YCCS, the sponsors and their agents have no responsibility for loss of life or injury to members or others, or for the loss, or damage to any vessel or property.

13. PHOTOGRAPHS AND TV RIGHTS

Competitors hereby grant the O.A., the unrestricted right and permission to use the name and the text, photograph or video footage of either themselves or the yacht they are sailing during the event, to be published or broadcast in any media whatsoever (including but not limited to Press and TV advertisements or Internet), for either editorial or advertising purposes or to be used in press information, in this respect, competitor's name and biographical material may also be used or reproduced in any way known.
