## 10 SUSTAINABILITY TIPS FOR SAILORS

- 1. Don't use plastic straws, plates or cutlery:** use reusable or compostable items. For example, bring your own reusable water bottle wherever you go, including when racing.
- 2. Separate your waste for recycling:** separate waste on board correctly and put it in the bins at the port where it will be collected.
- 3. Use environmentally friendly detergents and cleaning products:** for both personal hygiene and cleaning the boat.
- 4. Use eco-friendly sun creams:** chemical solar filters can contain ingredients that are not only harmful to our health but are also highly toxic to the marine ecosystem.
- 5. Do not waste water:** eliminate wastage and when rinsing the boat use flow restrictors to help reduce consumption.
- 6. Limit the use of fuel:** when you use the engine, don't have it on full power. Sailing more slowly will not only help you to save fuel (and money), but will also reduce the disturbance to marine fauna.
- 7. Prevent fuel loss:** remember that leaking pollutants such as gas, oil and petroleum into the water creates some of the worst damage to the marine environment. Refuel your boat when you are in port, not in the water, and check that there are no leaks from the tank or reserve tanks before setting off.
- 8. Protect the seabed:** dropping anchor and dragging it along the seabed can cause significant damage.
- 9. Respect marine protected areas:** each marine protected area has its own rules and regulations to be followed, be aware of them.
- 10. Become an ocean defender:** sign the Charta Smeralda and promote environmental sustainability. Each one of us through our choices can help to protect the environment!
