Divisions, Classes and Trophies

In keeping with NoR 4 ([NOR](#)), the Organizing Authority (OA) for the Giorgio Armani Superyacht Regatta will divide the fleet into divisions and classes. Based on [Entries](#) received as of the 1 May, 2023 entry deadline, it is the OA's intent to divide the fleet and award trophies as follows.

Divisions

There will be two divisions, the Monohull Division and Southern Wind Rendezvous Division.

Monohull Division Classes

The Monohull Division will feature three classes:

Combined Performance & Cruising Class A. The faster rated monohull yachts in fleet (trophies for 1st and 2nd place in class).

Inoui – Pattoo – V - Win Win

Cruising Class B. The slower rated monohull yachts in fleet (trophies for 1st and 2nd place in class).

Atalante - Free At Last - Gitana

Superyacht Cruising Class. Yachts from the Monohull Division that fall within the SYRA's cruising superyacht parameters ([Cruising Superyacht Definition](#)). Note that there is no 30.5 metre LOA requirement for this regatta (trophies for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in class).

Atalante - Free At Last – Gitana – Inoui – Pattoo - Win Win

The yacht that wins the Superyacht Cruising Class will be awarded the Silver Jubilee Cup (NoR 17.2).

Southern Wind Division

Aragon – Eginwave – Freebird - Ocean Horse – Sorvind - Starfall

Trophies for the Southern Wind Rendezvous Division will be at the discretion of Southern Wind.

Per NoR 4.1, the OA will post any update to class breaks, with any amendments if required, by 3 June 2023.
