Racing formats, scheduled starting sequence and starting lines for Wednesday, 6 September:

The racing on Wednesday will start an hour earlier with the first warning signal now scheduled for 11.00.

The Maxi Multihull, Maxi A, Maxi B, Supermaxi and Maxi C classes will sail coastal courses on Division 1.

The race committee will broadcast the two division rendezvous locations at **0900** on VHF 71.

The *intent* of the race committee is to provide W/L courses for Maxi A and Maxi B on Friday, 8 September.

Pin End Clarification:

- The intent of the Division 1 race committee is to use a service boat with orange flag for the pin end of the Long starting line and a robotic mark for the pin end of the Short line. For the Long starting line on Division 1, the robotic mark will not be part of the starting line.
- The intent of the Division 2 race committee is to use a robotic mark for the pin end of the starting line.
- The Long line will be approximately 850 metres and the Short line 550 metres.
