PROVISIONAL CLASSES AND TROPHIES

Based on final entries, the TCC sub-class limits have been adjusted ([NoR Amendment 3](#)). Based on the number of entries in each rating band and as allowed by NoR 3.2, 3.3 and 3.4, adjustments to classes have been made with some sub-classes combined into a single class.

With only three Maxi 2 entries and one Maxi 3 entry, the three Maxi sub-classes will be combined into one Maxi class (starting and scored together). The rules that apply to Maxi 1 regarding penalties and course choice will also apply to Maxi 2 and Maxi 3 in the combined Maxi class. With only four Mini Maxi 4 entries, the Mini Maxi 3 and Mini Maxi 4 sub-classes will be combined into one Mini Maxi class (starting and scored together).

A new sub-group created for foiling Mini Maxi boats will be designated Mini Maxi 0 (MM0).
