So as to ensure social distancing is maintained, inspection time slots will not be allocated this year. Instead, the reduced equipment inspection team will complete their work in the registration period from the dock, inspecting general layout. After racing they will be visiting the docks and asking teams to show them various items of safety equipment to ensure compliance with Special Regulations Cat 4 and IRC certificate compliance. All competing yachts will be issued with an IMA Certificate by the IMA ATO prior to completion of registration. Maximum Crew Numbers shall be as printed on the IMA Certificate. Copies will also be given to the Race Committee.
